A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

Thank you for your kindness in response to my talk at all the Masses last weekend in formally announcing the *Renew and Rebuild* Capital Campaign here at Sacred Heart. Please pray for the success of this Campaign for the good of our beautiful Church.

We look forward to welcoming Father Javier back home this week. He is coming a month earlier than usual to join us for the Final Mass and Gala Dinner Dance to celebrate the grand finale of our 150th Anniversary Year of Celebration. There are not many Parishes which have been in existence for a century and a half. Please come to the Anniversary Mass on the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus (Friday evening, June 8th at 7:30pm), and the Gala Dinner Dance at the Crowne Plaza on the following evening (Saturday, June 9th beginning at 6:00pm). Ticket sales for the Dinner Dance are a bit disappointing. Please try to purchase a ticket this week. We need your participation.

Today we celebrate the central Mystery of our Faith, The Most Holy Trinity. It is the mystery of who God is, a communion of persons in relationship - the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Three distinct Persons, one Divine Nature, one God. God is Love, as St. John puts it. Love is not just an attribute of God or something that God does, but is the very essence of who God is. And as many of the great Saints and Fathers of the Church have taught, Love is not solitary, but necessarily implies persons in relationship. There must be the one who Loves, the one who is Loved, and the Love that is shared between them. So, God in Himself is a communion of Persons, a Family, in an eternal relationship of mutual Love. Before anything came into being, the Father loves the Son, the Son loves the Father, and the love they have for each other breaths another Person, the Holy Spirit.

This tells us not only something about God, but also about ourselves since we are made in the image and likeness of the Blessed Trinity. Therefore, if God is a communion of persons in relationship, united in an eternal exchange of love, then our lives should mirror that. We then are made to live in relationships where love is freely given and freely received. We see this first and foremost in marriage and family life, which Saint John Paul II called an icon

of the Blessed Trinity. For just as in the inner life of the Trinity the love freely given and freely received between the Father and the Son is another Person, the Holy Spirit, so, too, is the love freely given and freely received between a husband and a wife capable of conceiving another person, creating a Family. How beautifully the image of the Trinity is imprinted upon the Family. Indeed, the mystery of the Blessed Trinity teaches us how we are supposed to be living in our individual families, in the family of the Church, and in the entire human family. May all of our families and our parish family always reflect the Love of the Most Holy Trinity. May God bless us all.
