### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

Summer is in full swing with the Fourth of July coming on Wednesday. How grateful we are to live in this great nation which has been such a force for good in our world.

We need to pray for our Country and our leaders. We have all seen the news stories about the problems at our nation's southern border and the immigration issue. The accounts we hear in the media conjure up very strong opinions on both sides of this issue and there are no easy answers. The Catechism of the Catholic Church recognizes the right and duty of every sovereign nation to protect its borders with a legal and orderly process for immigration. At the same time our faith teaches that every human person must always be treated with dignity and respect, which includes protecting refugees in emergency circumstances. We need to pray for wisdom and guidance for our government leaders, for those who are separated from their loved ones, and for the ability for people to talk about this problem with civility and respect.

With the Fourth of July this week we give thanks to God for our beloved Country and the freedom we enjoy. Our freedom is a great gift given to us by God, a gift which brings with it a great responsibility. May we never buy into the distorted notion so prevalent in our culture that sees freedom as a license to do whatever we want, rather than as a solemn responsibility to do what we ought - to seek what is good, virtuous, and true.

Look at these quotations from the founding fathers of our Country. **George Washington:** *"Religion and morality are the essential pillars of civil society."* **John Adams:** *"Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other."* **Thomas Jefferson:** *"God who gave us life gave us liberty. And can the liberties of a nation be thought secure when we have removed their only firm basis, a conviction in the mind of the people that these liberties are of the Gift of God?"* **James Madison:** *"We have staked the whole future of American civilization upon the capacity of mankind for self-government, upon the capacity of each and all of us to govern ourselves, to control ourselves, to sustain ourselves according to the Ten Commandments of God."*

Yes, our founding fathers new well that authentic freedom can never be divorced from God and His Divine Law. That is the principle upon which our great nation was built, and the only foundation upon which it will stand secure for generations to come. 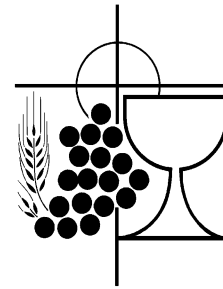
