### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

This weekend I will be speaking at all the Masses to make one last effort to reach our goal for the Renew and Rebuild Capital Campaign which every Parish in the Archdiocese of New York has or is currently running. I first want to thank all of you who have already so generously participated in this Campaign for your love and support of our beautiful Parish. With only 13% of our Parishioners making a pledge so far, we have raised 1.6 Million Dollars in pledges, 75% of the way to our goal of 2.1 Million Dollars. If we can raise that percentage of participation from 13% to 50% or more, we will be able to raise that remaining \$600,000 and achieve some wonderful projects for our beautiful Church to make it even more beautiful and structurally sound to stand for another 150 years and more. These projects will be done over the next 3 to 5 years, and what we are able to accomplish will depend on the success of this campaign. Today everyone will have a chance to make a pledge during Mass as we run one last "Commitment Weekend" with the intention of bringing the Campaign to a close by November 1<sup>st</sup>.

I haven't pushed the Campaign so far this Fall with the crisis our Church at large is facing. However, we must move forward and make one last push for the sake of our own beautiful Church here at Sacred Heart. You will recall that 74% of the money we raise is for our Parish with 26% going to the Archdiocese to support all its' charitable works, including the renovation of St. Patrick's Cathedral. Our goal of 2.1 million dollars encompasses the estimated cost of all the projects we hope to accomplish for our Church, plus the 26% that goes to the Archdiocese, plus our 2018 Cardinal's Appeal goal.

Everyone by now has received a letter asking for your support, and I know that many of you were shocked and even put off by the amount you were asked to give. Please remember that the asking amount was given to us by the Archdiocese. I completely understand that many cannot give the amount they were asked to give. Please, only you know your own circumstances. All I am asking is that you do whatever you can. I, too, have made a pledge of \$7,500, so it is not just me asking you, but we are doing this together. If you have any questions whatsoever, please call me at the Rectory. Let us

continue to work together to make our Parish stronger in every way. May God bless us all.

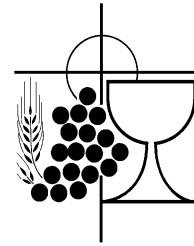
