### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

We were all horrified last weekend by the eruption of evil against our Jewish brothers and sisters worshiping God in their Synagogue in Pittsburgh. May God give eternal peace to all those who were killed, and consolation to their families and to all those traumatized by this unspeakable act of hate and anti-Semitism. The suffering of others reminds us that no matter what our race or religion, we are all part of the same human family, and when one member of our family is attacked out of hatred, it is an attack on us all. Let us pray for peace in our world and in our Country, and that violence, hatred and bigotry of every kind be banished from the human heart.

We have entered into the month of November with All Saints Day last Thursday and a beautiful Parish Mass of Remembrance for our deceased parishioners and loved ones who died this past year on Friday evening, All Souls Day. In fact, the entire month of November is dedicated in a special way to praying for the dead and focusing on the Final Judgement and the promise of Resurrection and Eternal Life. Even Nature at this time of year reminds us of death, as the trees become bare and the days become darker and colder as we approach Winter. But, Winter always gives way to Spring, the cold gives way to warmth, the darkness gives way to light, and the barren trees of Winter blossom with new life once again in the Spring. How beautifully God has written into nature signs of the Paschal Mystery, of our dying with Christ and rising with Him to New Life.

One beautiful sign of new life in our parish is the 22 new altar servers from our School and Religious Education Program who are being installed at the 10:00am Mass this weekend. What a beautiful way for our children to grow closer to Jesus and the awesome mystery we celebrate at Mass. We appreciate all our Altar Servers so much and thank them for so generously volunteering their time to serve in this special way. And I want to thank Father Charles for training and teaching them with such patience and precision. May our Lord Jesus bless all our Altar Servers abundantly and draw them ever closer to His Most Sacred Heart through their service at the Altar.

The month of November is also the time to prepare the annual year-end report to the Parish.

The numbers for our Sacramental statistics and financial statement are being prepared and will be presented in the bulletin in the next week or two. While the numbers will reflect a strong and vibrant Parish thanks to all of you who are so faithful and so supportive, you will note a marked drop over the past few years in Mass attendance and weekly collections. This is due in part to the fact that so many of our families have moved out of this area in the last several years. All we can do is our best to take care of our beautiful Parish and keep it strong in every way. May God bless us all.

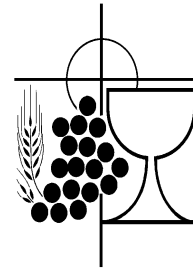
