Dear Parishioners:

I want to begin by saying once again how grateful I am for your generosity to our Parish this Christmas. Our Christmas Collection was fantastic, and with our weekly collections down significantly from last year, it is so much needed. It is a real testimony of your love and concern for our Parish and the value you place on your faith.

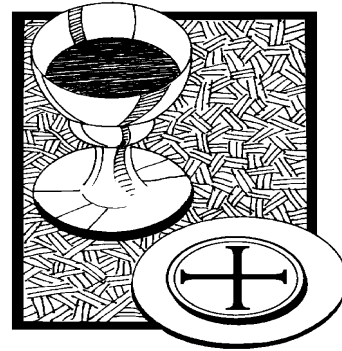
