### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

We are so happy to welcome Father Javier back home this weekend. Father Javier is here much earlier than usual to be a part of the great festivities for our Parish next weekend, the Ordination to the Priesthood of our own Deacon Walter Genito. Father Javier has known Walter since the day he was born. What a blessing it will be for all of us as Father Walter Genito celebrates his first Mass on Sunday afternoon, May 26<sup>th</sup>, at 2:30pm right here in our beautiful Church where Walter's vocation was nurtured throughout his years growing up, and where he was baptized, received his First Holy Communion and was Confirmed. It will be a powerful and inspiring Mass with more than 30 priests concelebrating. It doesn't happen very often, if ever, in a Parish, and how blessed we are that it is happening here.

It would also be a great experience for our children and young people, as well as for anyone, to attend the Ordination Mass at St. Patrick's Cathedral on Saturday morning, May 25<sup>th</sup>, at 9:00am. We have a bus leaving from here and will take names up until it is filled, or just go down to the Cathedral on your own. Please try to go, so that we can celebrate as a Parish Family the Priestly Ordination of one of our own Parish kids. Let us pray for Walter and give thanks to God for his priestly vocation. And let us pray for and thank his parents, Walter, Sr. and Bernadette Genito, for the gift of their son to the Church. It was in their home where Walter's vocation was conceived and took root and has blossomed in our midst.

In today's Gospel for this Fifth Sunday of Easter Jesus gives the *New Commandment* that drives every vocation: *"I give you a new commandment; love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another. This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."* Love drives us to go out of ourselves toward others, and even to lay down our life for others as our Lord Jesus laid down His Life for us. This is what we see lived out in marriage and family life, and what we should see in the Priesthood and Religious Life, as well as in the single life lived out in a self-giving way.

We are called to love *with the Love of Jesus*, and we cannot do that unless *His Love* is within us. And for us that means we need Jesus in the Eucharist by which *we remain in Him and He in us*. If we truly

reflected *His Love* in all of our words and actions, what peace and joy we would have in our hearts and would bring to others, beginning in our own homes. As Saint Catherine of Siena put it: *"If we truly were who we are supposed to be, we would set the world on fire."* Indeed, that is our mission, to set the world on fire with the *Love of Jesus*. May God bless us all.

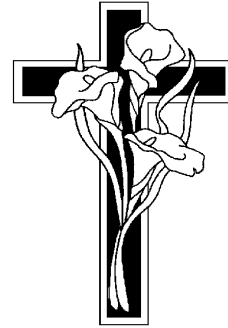
