### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

I first want to thank you for all the outpouring of love and support that so many of you expressed last week as I announced that I will be leaving our Parish and taking up a new assignment as Pastor of Saint Martin DePorres in Poughkeepsie as of July 1<sup>st</sup>. Again, for those who were not here, the Augustinian Recollect Fathers will be serving the Parish as your priests. We simply do not have enough priests to man all the Parishes in the Archdiocese and are relying more upon Religious Orders like the Augustinian Recollects for help. The Parish will still be as it always has been in the care of the Archdiocese of New York and Cardinal Dolan. I am pleased to announce that the new Pastor will be Father Michael Rafferty who has been the Prior up at Tagaste Monastery in the past and has said Mass for us here many times over the years.

As I said at all the Masses last week, the only thing that is changing are the priests who serve this Parish. There has been a lot of misinformation going around that the entire Rectory Staff, Henry and everyone else is being pushed out and replaced. **This is not what is happening.** No one has lost their jobs. I am sure that the new Priests who come in will work with and rely heavily upon the wonderful people we have working here and have been giving so much of themselves to Sacred Heart for so many years. Please know, too, that nothing will change regarding the pledges made for Renew & Rebuild. That money is restricted funds and must be used for nothing other than the projects we outlined for this capital campaign.

Let me just say again that I will miss all of you tremendously. This Parish is home to me, and I appreciate so much the love and kindness you have always shown to me. Let us always keep each other in prayer and keep our eyes fixed on Jesus.

Now, a very Happy Pentecost Sunday to everyone! This is one of the three greatest Feast Days of the Church's year, along with Easter and Christmas. This is the birthday of the Church, as the Apostles were filled with the Holy Spirit and thrust out of the womb of the upper room to preach the Gospel to people of every language, race, and nation on earth. The same men who fled out of fear on the night Jesus was arrested were now boldly and courageously bearing witness to Him in the face of great opposition. They were united in mind and in

heart and strengthened interiorly in their faith and in their love for the Lord and for one another.

May the Holy Spirit have the same effect in our lives, for we have all been given the same Holy Spirit who was poured out into our hearts at Baptism, sealed upon our souls at Confirmation, and deepened within us every time we receive the Holy Eucharist. Like the first disciples, we face a very difficult world, a culture which more and more promotes values and practices that are contrary to the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the teachings of His Church. How much we need those Gifts of the Holy Spirit to remain faithful in this difficult world: the **Wisdom, Knowledge, and Understanding** of the things of God; the **Right Judgment** to discern and to know what is right and wrong; the **Fortitude** to choose to do what is right even when it is most difficult; and the **Piety and Fear of the Lord** to Worship Him and to love Him with our whole heart, mind, soul, and strength. *"Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful and kindle in us the fire of Your Love."* May God bless us all.

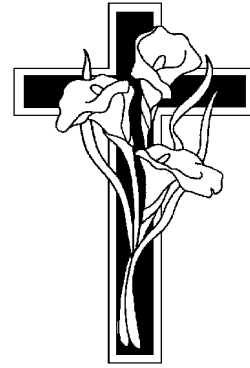
