A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

Today we celebrate the central Mystery of our Faith, *The Most Holy Trinity - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit* - three Persons, one God. God in Himself is a communion of Persons in an eternal exchange of Love. Many of the great Saints and Fathers of the Church used as their starting point in understanding this mystery better the words of Saint John: "*God is Love.*" They argue that *Love* is not solitary, but necessarily implies persons in relationship. There must be a Lover (The Father), the Beloved (The Son), and the Love that is shared between them (The Holy Spirit). Before anything came into being, the *Father* loves the *Son*, the *Son* loves the *Father*, and the love they have for each other *breathes* another Person, the *Holy Spirit*.

Since we are all made in the image and likeness of the Holy Trinity, we too should be living in relationships of love beginning in our own families. How beautifully the image of the Trinity is imprinted upon the Family. For just as in the inner life of the Trinity the love freely given and freely received between the Father and the Son *breathes* another Person, the Holy Spirit, so too is the love freely given and freely received between a husband and a wife united in marriage capable of generating another person in their children, creating a Family. This is the beautiful thought of Saint John Paul II who called the Family an icon of the Holy Trinity.

The Family as an icon of the Holy Trinity is a beautiful image for this Fathers' Day. A very happy Fathers' Day to all of our Dads! How grateful we are to our fathers who work so hard and sacrifice so much out of love to give their families the very best they can. May Saint Joseph, the patron Saint of fathers and the one God chose to be the provider and protector of the Holy Family, guide, inspire and strengthen all of our fathers to be true spiritual leaders of their families, instilling in their children a love for God and the values of faith, family, self-giving and sacrifice that life is really all about.

Another beautiful family celebration that occurred here this weekend was the Graduation Mass and Ceremony for the eighth graders of our School here in the Church on Saturday morning. May our eighth-grade graduates always look back on their time here at Sacred Heart School with fond memories as they look forward to new and exciting challenges in

their lives. Next weekend we will honor our High School graduates in a special way at the 10:00am Baccalaureate Mass as we come together as a parish family to congratulate them and to pray for them.

May all of our graduates know how much we love and cherish them and their families, and may they stay close to Jesus and His Church as the beautiful plan He has for their lives unfolds in the years ahead. May God bless us all.

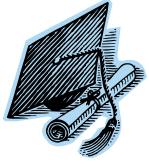

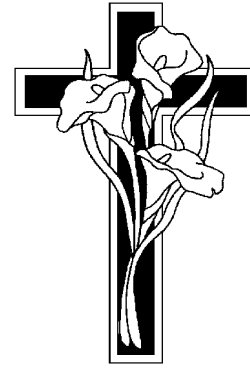
