PROPAGATION OF THE FAITH LAMP MINISTRIES

Once a year we have a missionary come to our parish and speak briefly at our weekend Masses on behalf of the Propagation of the Faith and their particular mission. This weekend we are happy to have a representative from LAMP Catholic Ministries share with us LAMP Missionaries are lay persons serve full-time among the materially poor, primarily here in the New York Archdiocese. They bring the Good News of the love of Jesus into areas where the Catholic presence is minimal or absent, such as shelters for the homeless families, crisis pregnancy street outreach in the south Bronx, through a street outreach of food and evangelization using a canteen truck, and other outreaches. There will be a second collection today to assist them in their missionary efforts.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK JESUS CAME TO HEAL THE WHOLE PERSON BODY AND SOUL

The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be God's will, the person be physically healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is the healing of the soul by which the sick person receives the grace of the Holy Spirit and the peace and consolation the Spirit brings to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age, or the anxiety of having surgery. Please call the Rectory and ask at any time if you or someone you know desires this Sacrament of Healing.

GODPARENTS & CONFIRMATION SPONSORS

When choosing a godparent / sponsor for a baptism or confirmation please make sure the person you choose meets the following requirements of Canon Law:

- Be at least 14 years of age and has received the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- Is a practicing Catholic who attends Mass every Sunday and Holy of Obligation
- If married, is married validly according to the Laws of the Catholic Church.


