Dear Brothers and Sisters of Sacred Heart,

Warm greetings (literally!) from Oxnard, California, minutes away from Almighty God's magnificent ocean at we Recollects' House of Initial Formation for aspiring candidates to the Augustinian Recollect vocation and priesthood...I am taking part, along with 21 other Recollects from around the world, in a week-long annual retreat- a fraternal encounter among us that rejuvenates us all in our various ministries. Within this week we too will once again celebrate the Holy Saints of the Church and we will honor all the beloved departed Souls...Speaking of holy- Fr. Fidel is celebrating, and we hope you will, too, children and parents, on October 27, a tribute to holiness called "Holy Wins"- Please call the Rectory and ask for Fr. Fidel and/or staff for further details about this event that takes the customary Halloween and unlocks the true meaning of what it means to be a saint: Indeed...That HOLY WINS!!

Upon returning to New York on Monday, I will spend two final days with my mom and family in Glens Falls. I cannot thank Frs. Fidel and John and staff enough for their untiring dedication to our beloved Sacred Heart Family. See you all soon.

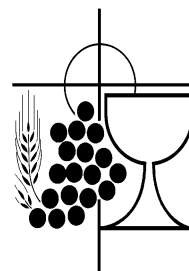
