Dear Sisters and Brothers of Sacred Heart:

In today's Gospel, the Sadducees, those who deny that there is a Resurrection were, as was usual for them, testing Jesus and trying to trip him up over a question pertaining to marriage. Jesus responded with "Those who are deemed worthy to attain to the resurrection no longer die for they are like angels."

Our Order of Augustinian Recollects just celebrated the commemoration of all its deceased members. On the heels of the Church's celebrations of All Saints and All Souls, we wish to share these beautiful and encouraging words of Saint Paul in his letter to the Corinthians:

"But as it is, Christ is now raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. Death came through a man; hence the resurrection of the dead comes through a man also. Just as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will come to life again. If there is no resurrection of the dead, Christ himself has not been raised and our preaching is void of content and our faith is empty. So, it is with the resurrection of the dead...What is sown in the earth is subject to decay, what rises is incorruptible and glorious; weakness is sown, and strength rises up. A natural body is put down and a spiritual body comes up."

Indeed, brothers and sisters...O' death, where is your victory!? O' death, where is your sting!? We are blessed to be a fellowship of believers that boldly proclaims: Jesus Christ has conquered sin and the grave! Alleluia!!

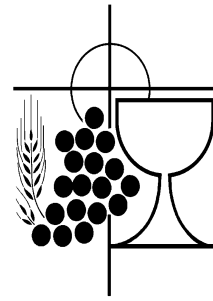
