

# ALL SAINTS NOVEMBER 1, 2020

From the priests' desks:

Dear brothers and Sisters of Sacred Heart:

Once again, we celebrate with Christians throughout the world the great feast of All Saints Day. St. Bernard of Clairvaux (1090-1153 AD) says that when we venerate the memory of the saints it serves us rather than them, since we are the ones in need, whereas they have already reached their goal. He goes on to encourage us to imitate them: "to aspire to dwell with the spirits of the blessed, to join the assembly of patriarchs, the ranks of the prophets, the council of the apostles, the great hosts of martyrs, the noble company of confessors, and the choirs of virgins." Descending from these general categories of saints, each one of us, hopefully, can find one or more saint whom we can feel moved to imitate, and who inspire the confidence that will lead us to pray for their intercession in our time of need: whether we are touched by the simplicity and humility of a Francis of Assisi, the missionary zeal of a Francis Xavier, the deep contemplative prayer of a Theresa of Avila or a John of the Cross, the self-sacrificing love of a Maximilian Kolbe, the humble service of a Mother Theresa of Calcutta, or the communitarian spirit of a St. Augustine of Hippo, the founder of our own community of Augustinian Recollects.

Last Halloween, two of our most popular saints showed up at the "Holy Wins" party for the children of Sacred Heart: Kateri Tekakwitha, the first Native American Saint, and Juan Diego, the faithful witness and transmitter of the message and the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe. These were not saints who walked on water or raised the dead, but rather ordinary people who made their faith real by the generosity of their lives and the depth of their faith; and who challenge us today and every day to lead more committed and active lives of faith and service in Jesus Christ, the One who is our model and guide, directing us to eternal life. Unfortunately, due to CoVid we cannot celebrate another "Holy Wins party" but the Saints will still go marching in!
