Dear Brothers and Sisters of Sacred Heart:

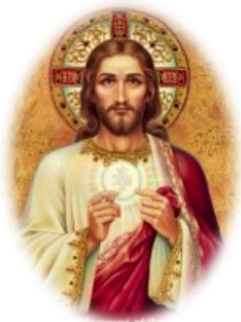

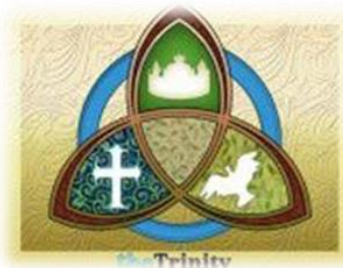
