Dear Brothers and Sisters of Sacred Heart:

*Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ*

How many Holy Communion of Jesus' most precious Body and Blood have I received since my First Holy Communion?

For sure so many to be counted, but for sure, our Lord Jesus Christ has formed me, nurtured me, guided me, forgiven me, healed me, protected me, strengthened me and saved me, among many other simple miracles.

**John 6:51** Gospel Acclamation

**I am the living bread that came down from heaven, says the Lord; Whoever eats this bread will live forever.**

Jesus the Living Bread from heaven, the eternal Word that became flesh and "dwelt among us" is here to stay with us, and in us [John 1]. For what reason, for His enduring love for each one of us, for true love is always unitive. True love always seeks the other and for the good of the other, even to the point of giving one's life so that the other may live. And if we are to live forever, Jesus our Lord is there to sustain us. St. Thomas Aquinas in one of his writings on the Body and Blood of Christ exclaimed:

But to ensure that the memory of so great a gift would abide with us forever, he left his body as food and his blood as drink for the faithful to consume in the form of bread and wine.

O precious and wonderful banquet that brings us salvation...No other sacrament has greater **healing power**; through it **sins are purged away, virtues are increased, and the soul is enriched** with an abundance **of every spiritual gift**. It is offered in the Church for the living and the dead, so that what was instituted for the salvation of all may be for the benefit of all. Yet in the end no one can fully express the sweetness of this sacrament in which **spiritual delight is tasted** at its very source, and in which we renew the memory of **that surpassing love for us** which Christ revealed in his passion.

Let us then treasure this great gift of Jesus for us. Let us receive Him worthily by coming to Jesus in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Let us return love for His Love by receiving Jesus humbly in Holy Communion and praising Him through works of charity and sacrifices.

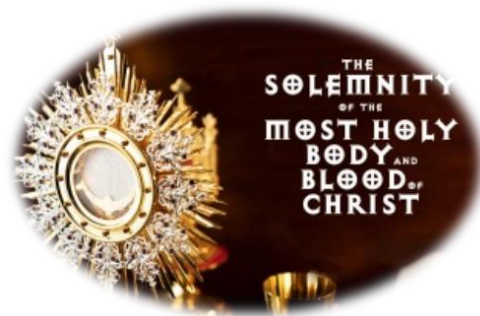
