Here is today's second reading of the seventeenth week in Ordinary Time...Saint Paul's letter to the Ephesians:

"Brothers and sisters:

bearing with one another through love,  
striving to preserve the unity of the spirit through the bond of peace:  
one body and one Spirit,

I am asking that you read it...then read it again...and again...and again! (You get the drift!)

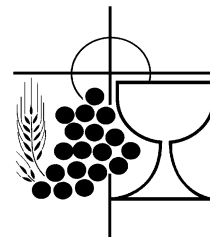
