Dear Brothers and Sisters of Sacred Heart:

The Assumption of Mother Mary is a dogmatic pronouncement of Mary entering heaven. First declared as dogma by Pope Pius XII, the holy father determined that "having completed the course of her earthly life, Mary was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory..." Pius XII nor any of his successors have ever said definitively whether Mary actually died BEFORE her assumption. What is said is that she was, however, most certainly assumed into heaven and the Church has rejoiced in this remarkable revelation with Mary ever since. Here is a tender poem by Saint Anthony of Padua:

dwelling other Savior, has been assumed bodily into

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

If you or someone you know have not been baptized or have not received the Sacraments of Holy Communion or Confirmation, and would like to, the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is meant for you. The RCIA is the process by which the Church receives new members into our Catholic community through the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist). It consists of instruction sessions and liturgical celebrations meant to inform individuals of the teachings of the Catholic faith, to help them discern whether they wish to become Catholic and to prepare them to be received into the Church at Easter. **These classes are also open to adult parishioners who would like to be more informed about their faith.**

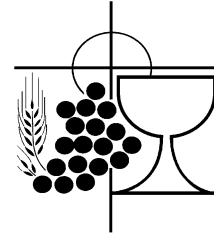
