Thomas Merton, Trappist monk and mystic, famously said this prayer in his effort to understand what it was that God was calling him to do with his life and in his ministry:

Lord, I have no idea where I am going. I do not see the road ahead of me. Nor do I really know myself. And the fact that I think that I am following your will does not actually mean that I am doing so. But I believe that my desire to please you does, in fact, please you. Give us the wisdom of your Spirit so that we can see the shape of your plans in the gifts you have given us and in the circumstances of our daily lives. Give us the courage to seek you with all our heart and to choose your Will above all else. We make this prayer through Christ our Lord. Amen. God Bless each of you today!
