

## Scripture Reflection

"The Lord knocks at the door -Who will answer?"

Jesus warns that money and possessions will not last and can be taken away at any moment by a thief or by death itself. 
#### **PARISH ACTIVITIES**

#### THE ASSUMPTION: THURSDAY, AUGUST 15

"The teaching [of the Assumption] was infallibly defined by Pope Pius XII on November 1, 1950 in the bull *Munificentissimus Deus* (Latin, "Most Bountiful God"). As Pius XII explained, this is "a divinely revealed dogma" (ibid.) This means that it is a dogma in the proper sense. It is thus a matter of faith that has been divinely revealed by God and that has been infallibly proposed by the Magisterium of the Church as such." Source: National Catholic Register




#### **GROWING IN FAITH – AUGUST ISSUE:**
