

Archbishop Michael A. Corrigan entrusted the care of the newly formed parish of St. Francis de Sales to the Missionary Fathers of La Salette in 1902. Rev. M. Julien Ginet, M.S., architect, builder and first pastor dedicated the church on Sunday, August 21, 1904. The Missionary Fathers returned pastoral care of St. Francis de Sales Parish to the Archdiocese of New York in 2003.

Scripture Reflection

The Cost of Discipleship

Jesus tells his would-be disciples that they, too, must count the cost if they want to succeed as his disciples. Jesus assures success for those willing to pay the price. All it costs is everything we have - the entirety of our lives and all we possess! What does Jesus have to offer that's worth giving up everything else? More than we can imagine! Jesus offers the gift of an abundant joyfilled life and the promise of everlasting peace and happiness with God for ever. Jesus was utterly honest and spared no words to tell his disciples that it would cost them dearly to follow after him and to invest in his heavenly kingdom. There can be no room for compromise or concession with God and his kingdom. We either give our lives over to him entirely or we keep them for ourselves. Paul the Apostle says, "We are not our own. We were bought with a price". That price is the precious blood of Jesus Christ shed for us upon the cross to redeem us from slavery to sin and death.

The love of God compels us to choose who or what will be first in our lives. To place any relationship or any possession above God is a form of idolatry. Jesus challenges his disciples to examine what they love first and foremost. The choice is ours, but the Lord does not leave us alone if we choose to follow him. NEW YORK CITY SNUBS MOTHER CABRINI

A public arts program in New York City initiated a project in June 2018 to recognize the contributions of women in helping to build the city. "Of the 150 statues in New York City, only five figure women. *She Built NYC* would spend \$5 million to build the new monuments." St. Francis X. Cabrini received the highest number of votes (219) – no one else came close.

Last month, the NYC selection committee skipped over Mother Cabrini in favor of other nominees to honor with a statue. This powerful woman religious came to the city

at the end of the 19th century with her Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. They worked tirelessly for poor immigrants and opened schools, hospitals, and orphanages in New York City and in over 15



countries throughout the world. St. Francis X. Cabrini was canonized in 1946 as the Patroness of Immigrants. The saint's remains are enshrined in her chapel in New York City and open to the public. Inspired by the Missionary Fathers of La Salette and the Blessed Mother, a small group of women in our parish formed Our Lady of La Salette Sodality in 1948. For over 70 years, Sodality members have dedicated themselves to the spiritual well-being of the Church. The Sodality sponsors retreats, programs and devotional practices such as the May Crowning of the Blessed Mother and reciting the Holy Rosary and Divine Mercy Chaplet among other events held during the year. The Sodality also helped support the parish by purchasing needed equipment and helping refurbish the Blessed Mother statues in our grotto.

The Sodality invites everyone to join us at 9:00 am Mass in the Church on the Feast Day of Our Lady of La Salette, Thursday, September 19. This day marks the anniversary of the Apparition of Our Lady of La Salette when our Blessed Mother appeared to two children near the town of La Salette, France in 1846.
