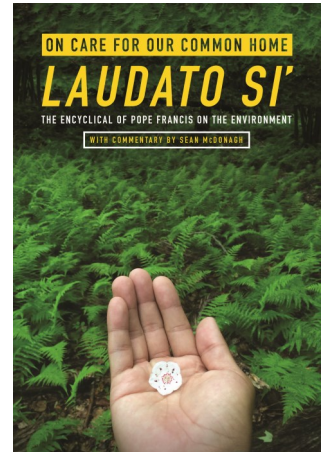


Reflections on Laudato Si: On Care for our Common Home
