THE DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA

This anniversary is a feast for all parishioners. St. John Lateran is, in a mystical sense, the parish church of all Catholics, for it is the Pope's parish... the Cathedral Church of the Bishop of Rome. This church is the spiritual home of the people who *are* the Church.

Saint Augustine said; "What was done here, as these walls were rising, is reproduced when we bring together those who believe in Christ. For, by believing they are hewn out, as it were, from mountains and forests, like stones and timber; but by catechizing, baptism and instruction they are, as it were, shaped, squared and planed by the hands of the workers and artisans. Nevertheless, they do not make a house for the Lord until they are fitted together through love."

The first basilica on the site was built in the 4th century when Constantine donated land he had received from the wealthy Lateran family. That structure and its successors suffered fire, earthquake and the ravages of war, but the Lateran remained the church where popes were consecrated until the popes returned from Avignon in the 14th century to find the church and the adjoining palace in ruins.

Pope Innocent X commissioned the present structure in 1646. One of Rome's most imposing churches, the Lateran's towering facade is crowned with 15 colossal statues of Christ,

John the Baptist, John the Evangelist and 12 doctors of the Church. Beneath its high altar rest the remains of the small wooden table on which tradition holds St. Peter himself celebrated Mass.

Catholics are also called to bring to mind the churches, basilicas, cathedrals, chapels, etc. in our lives (through travel, where we were married, baptized, ordained, etc.) that truly struck a chord with us as individuals where we truly felt the presence of God. This is the one that is remembered in that sense by our Catholic family at large.

DEDICACIÓN DE LA BASÍLICA DE SAN JUAN DE LETRÁN

Este aniversario es una fiesta para todos los parroquianos. San Juan de Letrán es, en un sentido místico, la Parroquia de todos los católicos porque es la Parroquia del Papa, la Catedral del Obispo de Roma, la casa espiritual del Papa que "representa" la Iglesia.

San Agustín decía: "Lo que se ha hecho aquí levantando estos muros, es reproducido cuando traemos a los que creen en Cristo. Porque por la fe han sido tallados como si fueran de montañas y bosques, como piedras y madera; pero por la catequesis, el bautismo y la instrucción han sido modelados, enmarcados y diseñados por las manos de obreros y artesanos. Sin embargo, ellos no conforman la casa del Señor hasta que se ensamblen todos juntos por medio del amor".

La primera basilica fue construida en el Siglo IV, cuando Constantino donó un terreno que había recibido de los "Letrán" una familia adinerada. La primera estructura y las siguientes sufrieron incendios, terremotos, y las destrucciones de la guerra pero la Basílica de Letrán continuó siendo la Iglesia donde los Papas eran consagrados hasta el regreso de Aviñón en el Siglo XIV, cuando encontraron la Basílica y el palacio lateral en ruinas.

El Papa Inocente X encargó la estructura presente en 1646. Es una de las más importantes iglesias de Roma, su fachada fue coronada con 15 estatuas colosales de Cristo, San Juan Bautista, San Juan Evangelista y 12 doctores de la Iglesia. Debajo de su gran altar se conservan los restos de una pequeña mesa de madera, en la cual, según la tradición, San Pedro mismo celebraba la Misa.

Los católicos son también llamados a recordar las iglesias, basílicas, catedrales, capillas, etc. En nuestras vidas, (cuando viajamos, cuando celebramos bodas, bautizos, ordenaciones, etc.) hay momentos que tocan nuestras fibras sensibles y donde realmente sentimos la presencia de Dios. Esto es algo que hay que recordar como familia católica.
