Before Communion:

After Communion:

My God, you are all mine; grant that I may be all yours in time and in eternity.

6th Grade Curriculum

Theme:

God's saving actions are found throughout history. The Bible, written under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, records God's plan of salvation.

Bible- Book containing God's word; It is also called Sacred Scripture or Divine Revelation. It contains the Old (46 books) and New (27 books) Testament.

Canticle- One of several liturgical songs taken from the Bible

Chosen People- The Israelites were the people chosen by God, the father of the chosen people was Abraham

Community- Group of people who share something important together.

Exodus- The escape of the Israelites from slavery in Egypt to freedom.

Incarnation- The mystery of God's Son becoming human

Inspiration- Process by which the Spirit of God has guided human beings in the composition of biblical writings

Lector- A reader of the Bible and other selections at Mass and other services of worship.

Manna- Bread-like substance that God sent to the Israelites in the desert.

Magnificat- A canticle of Mary from Luke 1:46-55

Paschal Mystery- The death and resurrection of Jesus. A mystery of our faith.

Passover- The feast celebrating the night death passed over the Israelites, but took the first born of the Egyptians.

Prophet- One sent by God to give us a new vision of what life could be like. Jesus the greatest of the prophets, gave us the vision of how to live in peace with all people.

Psalm- Songs of praise, thanksgiving, forgiveness and petition found in the Old Testament. (The book of Psalms)

Revelation- Act by which God can be seen in history of salvation, especially in the Bible

Worship- Praise and adoration given to God.
