7. Page 243 is a Unit Test. Have the student go back and find the people named in the box on page 243 and write a short description with the name in their notebook. Then they may answer the test questions.
Just send me the answers to questions 17 - 18, 19 - 20.
8. Complete Chapters 22 and 23 on Jesus, writing red words in their notebook.
9. Practice the Beatitudes and the Stations of the Cross
10. Pray and discuss the Lord's Prayer on page 253 together.

I miss seeing everyone on Thursday afternoon. They are a wonderful group of students. Please help them complete their work a little at a time so they are prepared when we get to meet in class again.
