In a onetime convent chapel at St. Mary of the Snow in Ulster County, the Shrine of the Holy Innocents is “dedicated to babies unborn, babies born to soon, infants and children who have gone home to God,” says Deacon Mike Sweeney. “We are a place of dignity and healing.” The modest chapel houses a growing number of plaques dedicated by grieving parents. Visitors can order a plaque for their own departed innocent, or just say a prayer in the presence of the existing plaques and in community with those who have suffered the loss of a child. Masses are offered in the chapel twice during the week, and there is an overnight Eucharistic adoration every Sunday evening


