The season of Lent begins this week on Ash Wednesday, March 6th. Lent is the penitential time of prayer, fasting, almsgiving and personal sacrifice meant to draw Christians more deeply into the sacred mystery of the Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection.



On Ash Wednesday, the traditional distribution of ashes will be distributed at each of the scheduled services at St. Peter's: **Mass at 10am, a Liturgy of the Word at 5:00pm, and Mass again at 7:30pm.**


