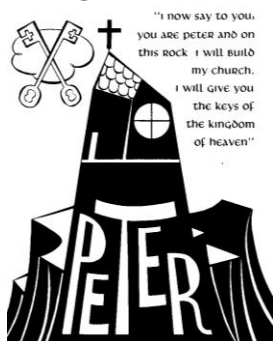

WHAT IS PERPETUAL ADORATION?

The Divine Mercy Perpetual Adoration Chapel at 469 Delaware Avenue, Kingston, NY is a treasure of the Hudson Valley. It

allows the faithful from many parishes in our region, the opportunity to unite in worship of the Eucharist outside of Mass. Adorers sign up for an hour of adoration before the Most Blessed Sacrament, both during the day and throughout the night.

HOW DOES ONE SPEND AN HOUR BEFORE JESUS?

You may bring your own prayer books read the Bible, pray the rosary, or just sit and relax and enjoy the sweet peace that comes from simply being in the Presence of God. You may feel that you can't pray well. Do not let this discourage you. The mere fact that you take time out at a specific time each week to spend an hour with Jesus pleases Him and is itself a prayer of great faith. Please remember that Perpetual Adoration is not just for a day, a week, a month, or a year. Rather, it is for always. It is not temporary, but ongoing and permanent.
