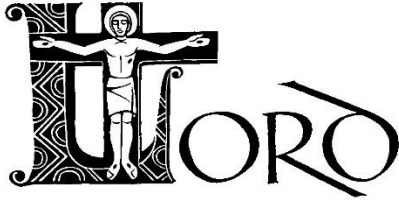

Please note the procedures below

If you have a cough or fever, please do not attend mass.
Wear your mask.
Keep space as you enter.

Sanitize your hands when you enter.
There will be no hymnals, bulletins or other printed material in the Church.
The Priest will not process down the center aisle before or after mass.
Wear your mask on the way to receive, remove it before receiving and return it immediately after receiving.

Receive by hand - out stretched. No Cup

Please return to your vehicle after mass - do not gather outside.

Please remember that for now there is no requirement for you to come back to Mass. Those who are at a greater risk of COVID-19 (those older than 65 or who have underlying health conditions) are cautioned not to come to church for Mass. WHAT IS PERPETUAL ADORATION?
The Divine Mercy Perpetual Adoration Chapel at 469 Delaware Avenue, Kingston, NY is a treasure of the Hudson Valley. It allows the faithful from many parishes in our region, the opportunity to unite in worship of the Eucharist outside of Mass. Adorers sign up for an hour of adoration before the Most Blessed Sacrament, both during the day and throughout the night.
HOW DOES ONE SPEND AN HOUR BEFORE JESUS?
You may bring your own prayer books read the Bible, pray the rosary, or just sit and relax and enjoy the sweet peace that comes from simply being in the Presence of God. You may feel that you can't pray well. Do not let this discourage you. The mere fact that you take time out at a specific time each week to spend an hour with Jesus pleases Him and is itself a prayer of great faith. Please remember that Perpetual Adoration is not just for a day, a week, a month, or a year. Rather, it is for always. It is not temporary, but ongoing and permanent.
