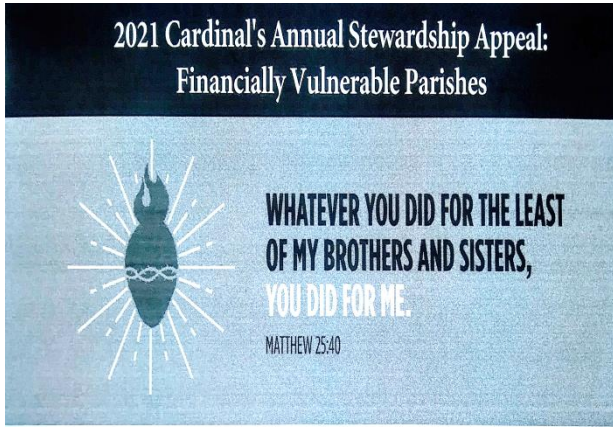
**MAY BABY SHOWER**
