Many of our students participated in the All County Orchestra Festival this weekend. Our students held an amazing 4 first chairs!

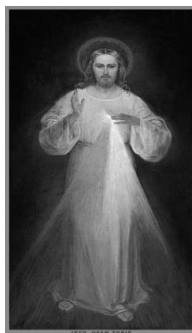
