HOLY THURSDAY APRIL 13, 2017 PILGRIM VISITS TO SEVEN CATHOLIC CHURCHES IN ULSTER COUNTY

A recommended practice for Lent is to go on a pilgrimage. A Pilgrim Pamphlet Guide will be made available on the Fifth Sunday of Lent and Palm Sunday for those who wish to participate in the venerable custom of 'visiting seven churches' on Maundy (**Holy Thursday, April 13, 2017**). The evening Mass time at each church, location of Altar of Repose, and closing time are listed in the pamphlet. Also included in the pamphlet are Pope Francis' intentions for April, and suggested verses to be prayed at each stop. Participants in the pilgrimage normally set out after attending the evening Mass of The Lord's Supper at their home parish; they continue on the self-directed pilgrimage to visit six more decorated Altars of Repose. Note that a Pilgrim Guide for visits to churches in Dutchess County is also available this year.
