Fr. Rick De La Peña

35 years in Priestly Ministry

Fr. Rick De La Peña was born on October 16, 1955 in Silay City, Philippines. He started his priestly formation when he enrolled in high school at Sacred Heart Minor Seminary in 1970. He finished his college in 1978 with the degree of Bachelor of Arts, major in Philosophy. He took his Theology course at St. Joseph’s Regional Seminary, Iloilo City, Philippines and was ordained in 1982 by Bishop Antonio Y. Fortich for the Diocese of Bacolod, Philippines. He served his Diocese for 12 years and the Bishop permitted him to work at St. Mary, Mother of the Church in Fishkill, NY when the Pastor asked Fr. Rick’s Bishop for an assistant. On July 1999, he was assigned here at St. Joseph’s Church, Kingston and continue serving the faithful until the present. He was incardinated for the Archdiocese of New York in 2001 and became a naturalized U.S. citizen in 2004. Join with Fr. Rick’s celebration next Sunday at 11:30 Mass.

Facts on Planned Parenthood

(1). Planned Parenthood is the largest abortion chain in America and has been responsible for the death of millions of innocent children at its facilities. It aborts hundreds of unborn babies daily.

Actions Do Not Coincide With Marketing

The amount PP has received from federal, state and local governments has been increasing steadily and has more than tripled since 1998. During the same period, the number of abortions carried out by PP has risen quite dramatically.

Revenue received from government has increased from \$165m in 1998 to \$541m in 2012 and the number of abortions at PP has risen from 165,509 in 1998 to 327,166 in 2012. While PP talks about reducing abortions, its actions speak volumes and negates its claims, has mandated that every affiliate must carry out abortions in all its facilities nationwide.
