Office for the Aging Notice on the Shingles' Vaccines

There are currently two vaccines available for protection against shingles: Zostavax and Shingrix. Zostavax is a single dose vaccine and Shingrix is a two dose series. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends Shingrix over Zostavax because it provides stronger protection against shingles disease. 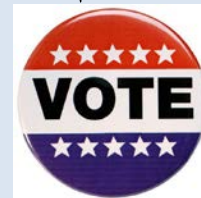
