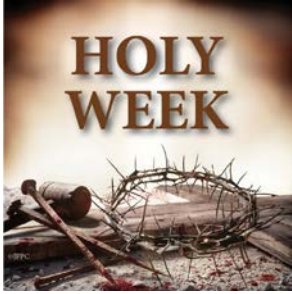
#### CHURCH GENERAL CLEANING
