Thomas Merton once observed that our desires for food and drink are something like little children in their persistence and tendency to dominate. Unless and until they are disciplined, they will skew the functions of the soul according to their purposes. Fasting is a way of quieting those desires by not responding to them immediately so that the deepest desires emerge.

What acts of self-denial can I offer this Lent to deepen my union with God?

RULES FOR FASTING and ABSTINENCE—fasting means eating only one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken which do not equal the full meal. Good Friday is a fast day. Everyone between the ages of 18 and 59 is bound to the fasting obligation. **Abstinence means not eating meat.** Meat consumption is forbidden on all the Fridays of Lent. This obligation begins at age 14 and has no upper limit.
