In Jesus' day the Roman Palestine area consisted of 5 districts: Judea, Samaria, Galilee, Perea and Idumea. There existed a deep-seated hostility between the Judeans and the Samaritans. Our Lord encounters a Samaritan woman who he asks for a drink of water; but as we heard in today's Gospel, it is our Lord who offers this woman "living water". Our Gospel is a story of hope and healing.

What "thirst" do I want to ask Jesus to satisfy today?

RULES FOR FASTING and ABSTINENCE—fasting means eating only one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken which do not equal the full meal. Good Friday is a fast day. Everyone between the ages of 18 and 59 is bound to the fasting obligation. **Abstinence means not eating meat.** Meat consumption is forbidden on all the Fridays of Lent. This obligation begins at age 14 and has no upper limit.
