The Sacrament of Confirmation has been changed to **Monday, November 2 at 7:00 p.m.** The Confirmation Retreat has been cancelled, but the two (2) sessions for Confirmation Program are going to be held on **Sunday, October 18 and Sunday, October 25** from 2:00 p.m.-5:00 p.m. All Confirmation candidates are expected to attend both sessions.
