**SATURDAY BIBLE GROUP**

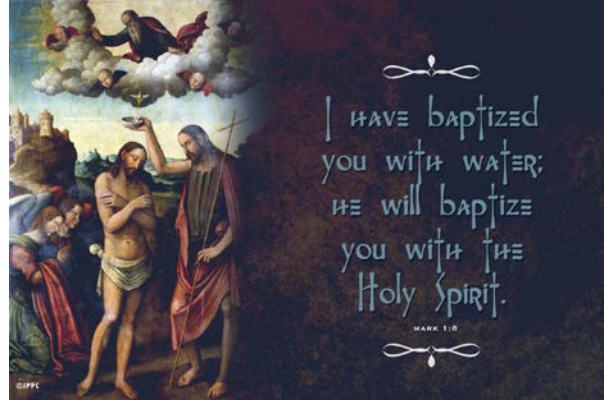
