### DIVINE MERCY ADORATION

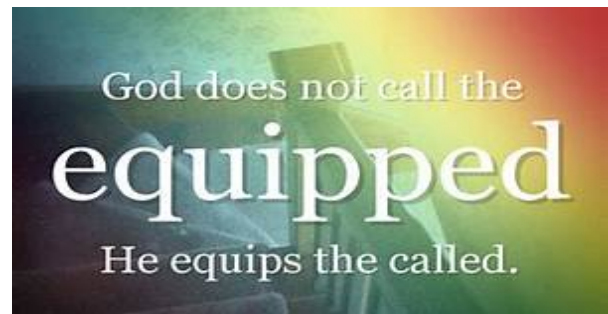
