*On Sunday, August 15<sup>th</sup>, Catholics and many other Christians celebrate the feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This significant feast day recalls the spiritual and physical departure of the mother of Jesus Christ from the earth, when both her soul and body were taken into the presence of God.*

*Venerable Pope Pius XII confirmed this belief about the Virgin Mary as the perennial teaching of the Church when he defined it formally as a dogma of Catholic faith in 1950. What the pope solemnly declared was already a common belief in the Catholic Church since we find homilies on the Assumption going back to the sixth century.*

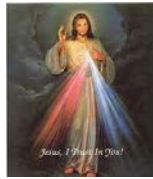
