



A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS **HIS WORD TODAY** by Rev. William J. Reilly

Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time August 12, 2018

"Elijah prayed for death, saying: This is enough, O Lord. Take my life, for I am no better than my fathers. He lay down and fell asleep under the broom tree, but then an angel touched him and ordered him to get up and eat...for the angel of the Lord came back a second time, touched him and ordered 'Get up and eat, else the journey will be too long for you.' He got up, ate and drank...he walked forty days and nights to the mountain of God, Horeb."

We return to Capernaum and find Jesus telling us 'I AM the bread of life.' It is in the Eucharist we find Jesus present to accompany us on our journey. Elijah was awakened twice and was ordered to brace himself for the journey. Jesus is the bread of life for us. We often overlook how great, how important, how necessary is this gift for our spiritual survival.

How many people in the world die each day of starvation? Too many, and we are called to assist them. How many people in the church take the gift of the Eucharist for granted? We speak of a priest shortage, while we should focus on the lack of appreciation for the gift of the Eucharist. Where in our world are people deprived of what is so essential, yet we sometimes take the priesthood, the mass and Eucharist for aranted.

If Jesus is the bread of life, I need to go to Him with renewed fervor and gratitude. 'Get up and eat, else the journey will be too long for you.'
