## *From the Pastor's Desk...*

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Everything around our Church and school is so quiet. Our school children are on summer break and some of our families have already left for summer vacation. Not only the Sunday Masses are less crowded, even the rectory is less crowded because Fr. Joselin is away. He left on June 25<sup>th</sup> for his vacation to visit his family. He will spend ten days with his family in India and then his religious order superiors have assigned him to spend a month in South Sudan in in Africa in one of their mission stations. He is scheduled to be back with us on 11<sup>th</sup> of August. Fr. Charles and I are around guarding the Fort. I can't wait for September to get back to the normal busy parish life.

These days I am reading books by Mathew Kelly who is a New York Times best-selling author of sixteen books. I just completed reading his book **Rediscover Catholicism** and now I am reading **The Four Signs of a Dynamic Catholic**. In it he says, "If you walk into any Catholic Church Sunday and look around, you will discover that some people are highly engaged, others are massively disengaged, and the majority are somewhere in between. Why? What is the difference between highly engaged Catholics and disengaged Catholics?"

He says that answering this question is essential to the future of the Catholic Church. He goes on to write that the four things that make the difference between highly engaged Catholics and disengaged Catholics are the four signs of a Dynamic Catholic. These four signs are:

1. **Prayer**
2. **Study**
3. **Generosity**
4. **Evangelization.**

In order to accomplish these four things he challenges every Catholic in every parish to do the following:

1. **Spent ten minutes each day in prayerful conversation with God.**
2. **Read five pages of a great Catholic book each day.**
3. **Give 1 percent more of your income to support the mission of your parish than you did last year.**
4. **Do one thing each week to share the genius of Catholicism with someone else.**

I wish and pray that all our parishioners can accept Mathew Kelly's challenge and become highly engaged Catholics.
