NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: I Kings 19:4-8

Queen Jezebel had vowed to kill Elijah, who went into the desert and prayed for death. Instead he went to sleep and was awakened by an angel, who told him to eat the food God had given him. He ate and went back to sleep, but God's angel again woke him and told him to eat. Strengthened by the food, he got up and walked forty days and nights to the mountain of God.

Second Reading: Ephesians 4:30—5:2

Paul appeals to the Ephesians to get rid of bitterness, anger, and malice. Instead they must be kind, compassionate, and forgiving just as God has been. We must be imitators of Christ, and love one another as he has loved us.

Gospel: John 6:41-51

The Jews were not convinced that Jesus was the bread that came down from heaven. But he again explains that he is the bread of life. He tells them that anyone who believes and eats this bread shall live forever. He explains that the bread he will give is his flesh, for the life of the world.

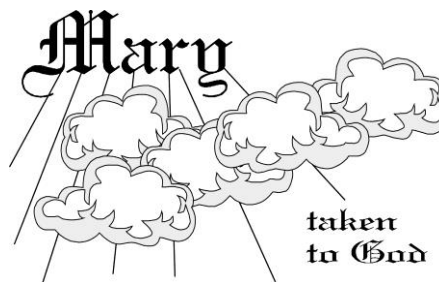

Fr. Joselin update: Our Fr. Joselin sent me two messages ; one immediately after reaching home in India saying that he reached there safely and his family members are thrilled to see him. I got the second message recently. He writes, "Hi Father, I am in South Sudan enjoying my life with my priests, visiting the parishes, the people and saying mass. We (His religious order-Missionaries of Mary Immaculate) have 8 parishes here and the distance between each parish is 100 kilometers (roughly 62 miles). I have been visiting all the parishes and I am in the 6th parish now. In the next 10 days I will be visiting another 2 parishes. My priests and sisters here take care of me well. I too am very happy here but still I miss all of you. Tell our people I am happy, safe and sound. See you on August 11"
