**TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

**First Reading: Isaiah 50:5-9a**

Isaiah describes the willingness of the Suffering Servant to submit to the persecution of his enemies. This willingness stems from true faith in God, and the knowledge that the Lord will always be his help.

**Second Reading: James 2:14-18**

James states that if some one is hungry and you wish them well but do not help them, you have done them no good. He compares this to stating your faith, without backing it up with your actions. He reminds us that we must show our faith through our good works.

**Gospel: Mark 8:27-35**

Jesus taught his disciples that as the Messiah, he had to suffer much, be put to death, and rise three days later. Peter began to disagree and Jesus reprimanded him for judging by human standards rather than by God's. He told them that whoever would be willing to lose their life for the sake of Jesus and the gospel, will in fact preserve their life forever.

## *From the Pastor's Desk...*

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Summer 2015 is behind us now and the new school year has come upon us like "ready or not here I come". I wish all the teachers and students who begin their school year all God's blessings and Blessed Mother's protection.

As requested by our Cardinal in his appointment letter I will be canonically installed as Pastor by Rev. Msgr. Peter Finn at the 4 p.m. Mass on Saturday, September 19, 2015. I will make the Profession of Faith and take the Oath of Fidelity during the installation ceremony. All are welcome to join me in prayer.

I know that all are eagerly waiting for the Holy Father's visit to New York and some of you have registered for the tickets with the parish. Last Sunday our Cardinal sent an email to all the priests regarding the visit. Let me add some of the high lights for all to know:

"The Mass at Madison Square Garden on Friday begins at 6:30 pm, and we expect it to conclude by 8:00 pm. As you know, the Holy Father is also a head of state, and so the United States Secret Service (USSS) requires that everyone arrive very early for the Mass to accommodate the security checkpoints and the likelihood of lines and waits to enter the arena. **We ask all attendees to arrive outside Madison Square Garden by 2:00 pm...**"

"The Pope's visit coincides with the 70th Anniversary of the United Nations General Assembly. The New York Police Department and the United States Secret Service are expecting as many as 200 world leaders to be in the City, so it will be difficult to get around. We expect there to be many street closures and gridlock, and we, therefore, **strongly encourage every attendee to take mass transportation.** If someone drives to Manhattan, it is very likely that they will experience trouble getting around and finding parking to the point where they will miss the window of opportunity to enter Madison Square Garden on time. There are plenty of mass transportation options, and we are working with the key transportation organizations to have extra service added to accommodate the Mass attendees.
