First Reading: Amos 8:4-7

The prophet Amos expressed disgust over people who take advantage of the poor. He describes businessmen scheming to cheat the poor, then declares that God will "never forget the things they have done."

Second Reading: 1 Timothy 2:1-8

Paul urges the Christians to pray for all people, especially those in authority. Paul even asked them to pray for the kings who denounced Christ's teachings, because God wants all people to be saved through Jesus.

Gospel: Luke 16:1-13

Jesus tells a story about a servant who tries to cheat his employer. The owner is impressed because he would do the same thing himself. Jesus then describes the importance of being trustworthy in small matters, as well as in greater ones. He then states that no one can serve two masters faithfully, so people cannot give themselves completely to both God and money.

From the Pastor's Desk...

My Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In my last week's column, I wrote that this week I will write about some of our parish financial concerns. Before I do that I have one important good news to share with all our parishioners as a continuation of our efforts for spiritual nourishment like the Parish Mission we announced last week for October 8th week.

In late August I got a letter from His Eminence Cardinal Dolan stating that the Archdiocese through the generosity of a benefactor will subscribe for one year to a website named **FORMED.ORG which has in one place all the Catholic contents like faith formation programs, Bible Studies, Catholic-themed movies, and e-books and much more.** I was delighted to hear this good news. Sure enough last week I received the Parish Code for this website and checked it out. It is excellent. It is so good that I would be more than happy to continue the subscription to this site after one year if all our parishioners would use and benefit from it. Please note the following info to access this site for our parishioners:

Go the website formed.org and enter the parish code. Register yourself and use it unlimited for one year.

Now regarding money matters, I am always grateful to all of you who generously help the parish. But it is good to update you with the latest situation. From 2007 we have done very well. We built a beautiful handicapped access ramp, put new roofs for the school building, repaved the side-walks around the school and in front of the rectory, paved the school parking lot, renovated Fr. Hopkins Hall, Rectory Meeting Room plus the basement, and completed total renovation of the Church and Chapel. We water proofed the Old Convent and renovated one floor to use it as Kindergarten class rooms. This year we have pursued the completion of convent renovation and bringing it to full use with the new fire-alarm system, sprinkler system and an elevator. Believe it or not in all these years the collections have remained the same and now I see that it is going down. The truth is out of 2027 registered families only 500 or so parish families use the envelopes to donate. Out of the 500 envelope users 20 families still give only \$1.00 in the envelope. Many do not use the envelopes and some still give \$2.00 and \$5.00 in the weekly envelopes. Even when I did the special renovation campaign only 300 families participated. At this rate it is very difficult to sustain the parish and pay all the bills. So far we have reduced our expenses to the minimum and not requested for any help or loan from the Archdiocese. That is truly God's miracle. The Archdiocese is initiating a major campaign in all the parishes. We will begin this campaign in our parish soon. My request to you is please respond generously to the campaign and increase your weekly contribution a little to our beloved Church.
