FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Amos 7:12-15

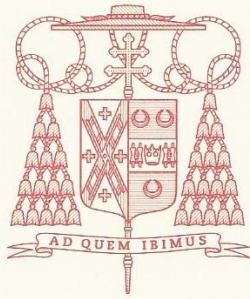
