**EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

**First Reading: Exodus 16:2-4, 12-15**

The Israelites complain that Moses led them to the desert and there is no food for them there. Then the Lord told Moses he would rain down bread from heaven so the people might know that "I, the Lord, am your God." God did as he had promised and in the morning the people found the bread that he had given them.

**Second Reading: Ephesians 4:17, 20-24**

Paul tells the Ephesians that they must give up their old way of life in accordance with the truth that Christ has brought them. He reminds them to acquire a spiritual way of thinking, and to remember what they are made in God's image and act accordingly.

**Gospel: John 6:24-35**

The people Jesus had fed on five loaves of bread follow him, and Jesus tells them they should not be looking for perishable food, but for spiritual food. The people want a sign that they should believe in him. He explains that he is the bread of life, and anyone who believes will not experience hunger or thirst. The people did not fully understand that he was speaking in the spiritual sense, and not of actual food.

## *From the Pastor's desk ...*



It is an honor and privilege to be your priest and serve you in the Lord. Let me share a brief history of myself. I was born and raised in Kerala, a beautiful state in the Country of India. My parents were farmers and I have eight siblings; ordained to the Priesthood on May 7, 1987, as a member of the Missionary Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament.

Initially, I served in our religious order as Procurator, Rector and Teacher at the Minor Seminary while earning college degrees in Philosophy, Arts, and Theology and a Masters and licentiate in Indian Philosophy.

Coming to America in 1997, I served as an Associate Pastor at Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Pelham Manor in New York. In 1999, served for one year as an Associate Pastor at a parish in Dublin, Ireland. Returning to the United States in 2000, served as an Associate Pastor at St. George Parish in Guilford, Connecticut. While living in Connecticut, earned an additional degree in Moral Theology from Yale University. In 2004 served as Associate Pastor in West Allis, Wisconsin. In 2005, then Archbishop Dolan appointed me as Pastor of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish in Kenosha, Wisconsin. In 2006, the Archbishop appointed me to a second Pastoral assignment at St. James the Apostle Parish, also in Kenosha.

Working closely with the Milwaukee Archdiocese, I was granted permission to bring over three additional Priests from my religious order to help with the Priest shortage. Many of my former students are now being ordained and are most anxious to serve.

After serving 10 years in the Milwaukee Archdiocese, in June of 2015, I was again called to relocate to St. Bernadette mission parish in Butner, North Carolina. After serving as Administrator there for one year, I came back to Southeastern Wisconsin and served the good people of Saint Benedict in Fontana (Lake Geneva) as an Administrator. Parish mergers then brought me to the Milwaukee Catholic Home community.

I am looking forward to helping strengthen the community of Our Lady Queen of Peace and bringing all spiritually closer to God, Jesus, and Mary and to each other as members of God's family through sacramental ministries, one-on-one interactions, and ministering to our parishioners and their families. My humble prayer is that we all become God's blessings to each other.
