First Reading: Acts 2:1-11

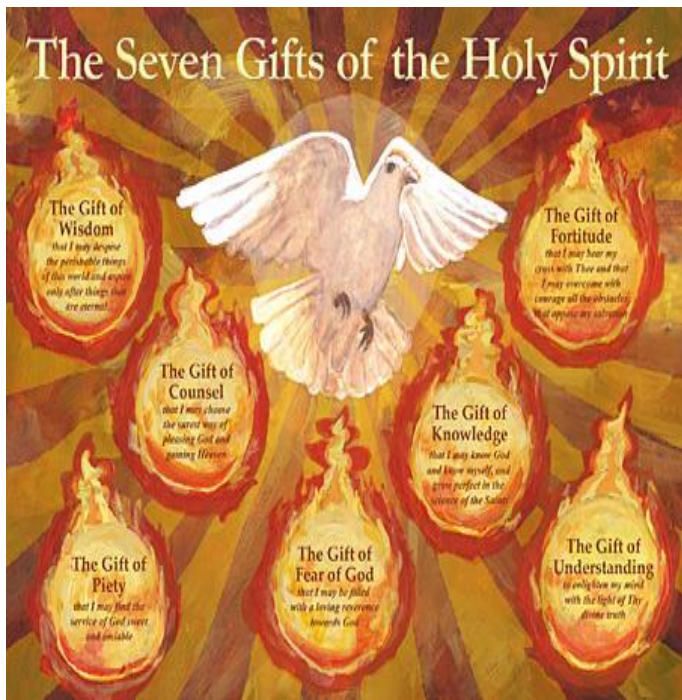


Our Sanctuary Lamp
