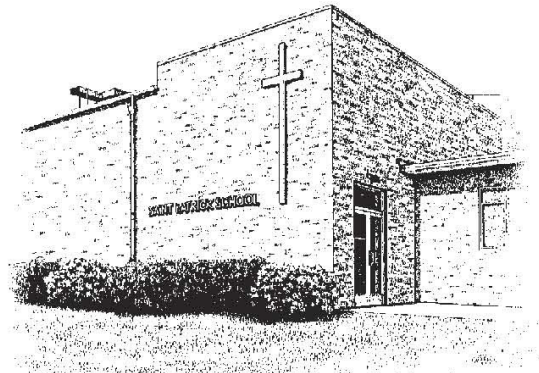

**JANUARY 27, 2019**

**First Reading: Nehemiah 8:2-4a, 5-6, 8-10**

Ezra gathered the people and read to them from the book of the Law of God. He interpreted the law clearly, so that everyone understood what he had read. He then told them to go and rejoice in the Lord.

**Second Reading: I Corinthians 12:12-30**

Paul explains that a body is composed of many different parts, and that each part has its' own purpose and is important. He compares this to the Church, describing how we are one body composed of many members. All members should show concern for each other and understand that we are all vital to the body as a whole.

**Gospel: Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21**

Luke discusses his decision to write about the events he and the other disciples had witnessed. He begins by telling of Jesus reading a passage from the book of Isaiah, where the anointed one is portrayed. Jesus finished by telling the people that they had seen that passage fulfilled in their hearing.

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### Presentation of the Lord, Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup>

At the end of the fourth century, a woman named Etheria made a pilgrimage to Jerusalem. Her journal, discovered in 1887, gives an unprecedented glimpse of liturgical life there. Among the celebrations she describes is the Epiphany (January 6), the observance of Christ's birth, and the gala procession in honor of his Presentation in the Temple 40 days later—February 15. (Under the Mosaic Law, a woman was ritually "unclean" for 40 days after childbirth, when she was to present herself to the priests and offer sacrifice—her "purification." Contact with anyone who had brushed against mystery—birth or death—excluded a person from Jewish worship.) This feast emphasizes Jesus' first appearance in the Temple more than Mary's purification.

The observance spread throughout the Western Church in the fifth and sixth centuries. Because the Church in the West celebrated Jesus' birth on December 25, the Presentation was moved to February 2, 40 days after Christmas.

At the beginning of the eighth century, Pope Sergius inaugurated a candlelight procession; at the end of the same century the blessing and distribution of candles which continues to this day became part of the celebration, giving the feast its popular name: Candlemas.

*Comment:* In Luke's account, Jesus was welcomed in the temple by two elderly people, Simeon and the widow Anna. They embody Israel in their patient expectation; they acknowledge the infant Jesus as the long-awaited Messiah. Early references to the Roman feast dub it the feast of St. Simeon, the old man who burst into a song of joy which the Church still sings at day's end.

## ST. PATRICK'S SCHOOL APPLICATION PROCESS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2019-20

**Procedure:** Appointments must be made by telephone, call 718-979-8815 for an interview for the week of **January 29<sup>th</sup>**.

**Requirements:** PreK-3 (three years by 12/31/18); UPK-4 (four years by 12/31/18); Kindergarten (five years by 12/31/18); and First Grade (six years by 12/31/18). Child must be present.

*Certificates for ALL Grades:* (a) Birth; (b) Baptismal (if Catholic or Christian); and (c) Immunization-complete records, including name of doctor. No child can be accepted without proper immunization.

*Additional Requirements for Grades 1+:* (a) Standardized tests results (b) Report Cards; and (c) Work Samples. All certificates must be submitted at appointment date.

**Registration Fee:** \$75.00 for 1 child; \$100 for two or more

**Tuition:** Only those active parishioners who present their envelope number at registration, who participate in the life of the parish and support the parish, will be given a parishioner's tuition rate.
