**Property Related:**

- Houses that once stood on the parish grounds on Grace or LaBoiteaux before 1954
- Original Rectory house interior photos, especially of the chapel on the 2nd floor
- Schweiterman house on Galbraith Rd.

**Old Church Related:**

- Old church construction (circa 1921)
- Interior view of the back of the old church building and the loft/organ area
- Any photos of the old church altar over the years
- Demolition of the old church
- Any interior photos of the old church during occasions such as weddings, First Communion, May Crowning, etc.

**Construction Related:**

- Demolition of the houses on Grace or LaBoiteaux
- Moving of the house on LaBoiteaux to a lot across the street from the convent
- Moving the Rectory house to Goodman Ave.
- Interior of the chapel area in the school building that was located in the space where the four classrooms are now at the end of the new wing

**School Related:**

- Events taking place in the auditorium or cafeteria during any year
- The school being built in 1923
- Various phases as the school was added on to over the years in 1929, 1945, and 1954
- The cafeteria before 1945
- The auditorium before 1945
- The projection room
- The interior of the Wanninger house on LaBoiteaux when it was used as classrooms and office space

**Events Related:**

- Annual Corpus Christi altars erected by parishioners in their yards and decorated with flowers and Fr. Wellman's processions around the neighborhood to visit and bless them
- May Crownings (on Grace Ave. side, at bell tower, or in the church)
- Dedications conducted by a bishop or the Archbishop, such as the buildings, cornerstones, altars, etc.
- Blessing of the bells and the bell tower
- First Communions, graduations, weddings, first Masses for our parish religious
- Parish Picnic, recent or early years
- Festivals, recent or early years
