Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time (C)

From the Desk of Rev. Msgr. Hugh J. Corrigan:

“Renew and Rebuild” is the name of the Archdiocesan Capital Campaign to raise money for the needs of the Archdiocese and our Parish. 74% of the money will be used to repair our stained glass windows. The overall goal is \$200 million to be collected over five years. “The Renew and Rebuild” organization sets the goal for the parish (ours is \$404,000.) and has a three stage process which we must follow. By the beginning of November all the details of the campaign will be explained.

Parking in our parking lot has been a problem for parishioners attending the 11:00 a.m. Mass on Sundays. The following regulations should help the situation.



Parking at St. Mary’s on Sundays: We are having a problem between the 9:00am Mass and the 11:00am Mass. There are few parking spaces in the lower parking area for parishioners who want to attend the 11:00am mass. Solution: all cars in the lower parking lot owned by parishioners from the 9:00am Mass must be gone by 10:45am. If you want to stay beyond 10:45am you can park your car in St. Mary’s upper parking lot, or in the Cacace Parking Facility across the street from our church or in the parking lot of the former Mary the Queen Convent



COLLECTION: the collection for last Sunday September 25, 2016 was \$4321.




